KIPP Wheatley encourages a balanced approach to literacy instruction that includes close reading, independent reading, language study, and writing every single day. Research and experience show that effective literacy programs build students' word and world knowledge, integrate reading and writing instruction, align with college-ready standards, and are centered on authentic, high-quality texts.

KIPP Wheatley is designed to be part of an ELA block that also includes independent and guided reading of text at students' reading levels and phonics for grades K-5.

KIPP WHEATLEY AND THE STANDARDS

The three key literacy shifts of the CCSS are the heart and soul of the curriculum, including:

1. Regular practice with complex texts and their academic language
2. Reading, writing and speaking grounded in evidence from texts
3. Building knowledge through content-rich nonfiction

KIPP Wheatley addresses all CCSS in Reading (Informational and Literary), Writing, Language, and Speaking and Listening.*

KIPP Wheatley is also appropriate for schools in states not following the CCSS. KIPP Wheatley focuses on skills and content that all students need for academic and career success: close reading of high-quality, complex texts and thorough, precise writing.
