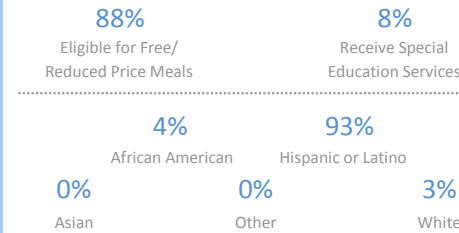

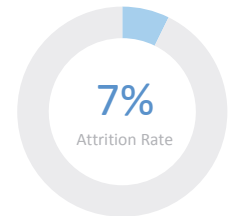

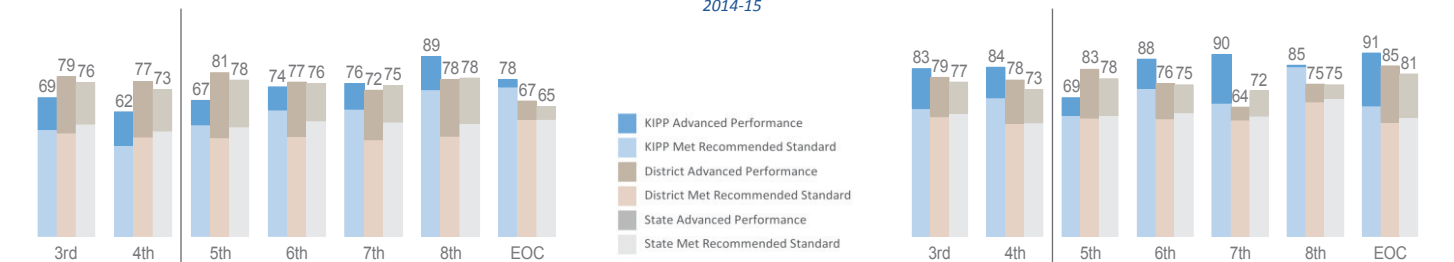


HOW ARE WE PERFORMING RELATIVE TO OUR LOCAL COMMUNITY?

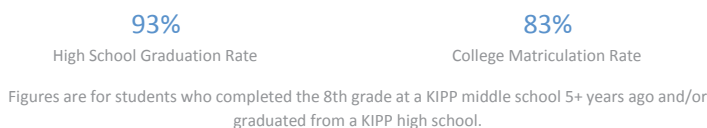

In 2014-15, KIPP Austin Public Schools did not administer MAP Reading to its Kindergartners. In the quartile graphs, the Fall Kindergarten Math MAP results shown only represent Austin Comunidad, and the Spring Kindergarten Math MAP results only represent Austin Comunidad, Austin Leadership Elementary, and Austin Obras. All school, district and state scores reflect a combination of tests taken in English and Spanish. According to the Texas Education Agency, the Spanish-language tests assess the same grade-level academic skills as the English-language tests. State test scores for the 5th and 8th grade include data from the first test administration only.
