

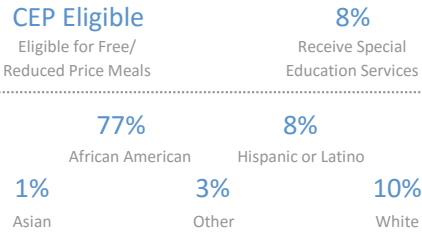

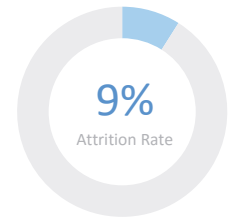

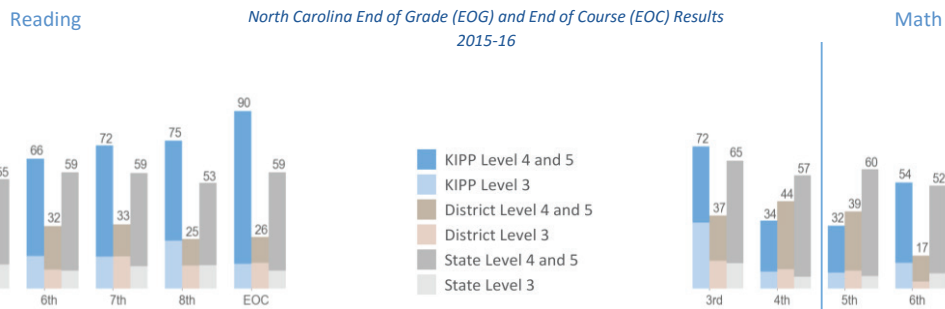

HOW ARE WE PERFORMING RELATIVE TO OUR LOCAL COMMUNITY?

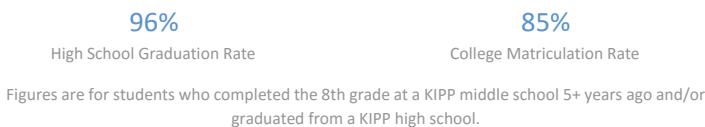
North Carolina End of Grade (EOG) and End of Course (EOC) Results 2015-16
